tree.





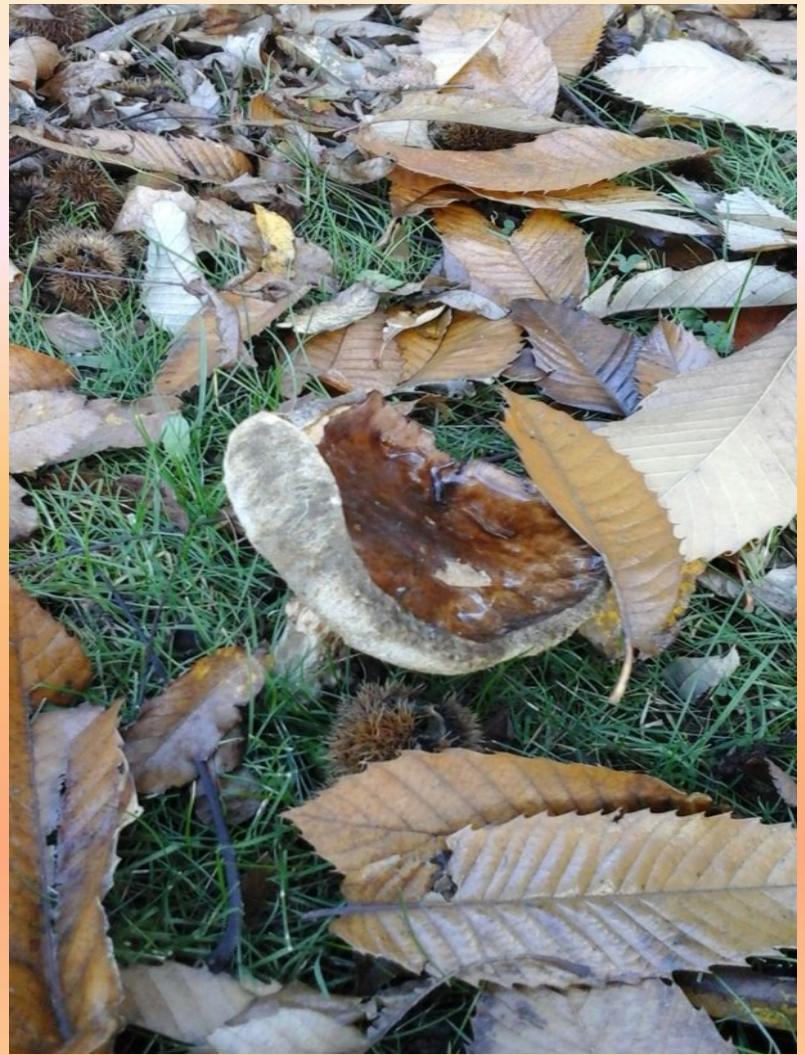
We

leaves!

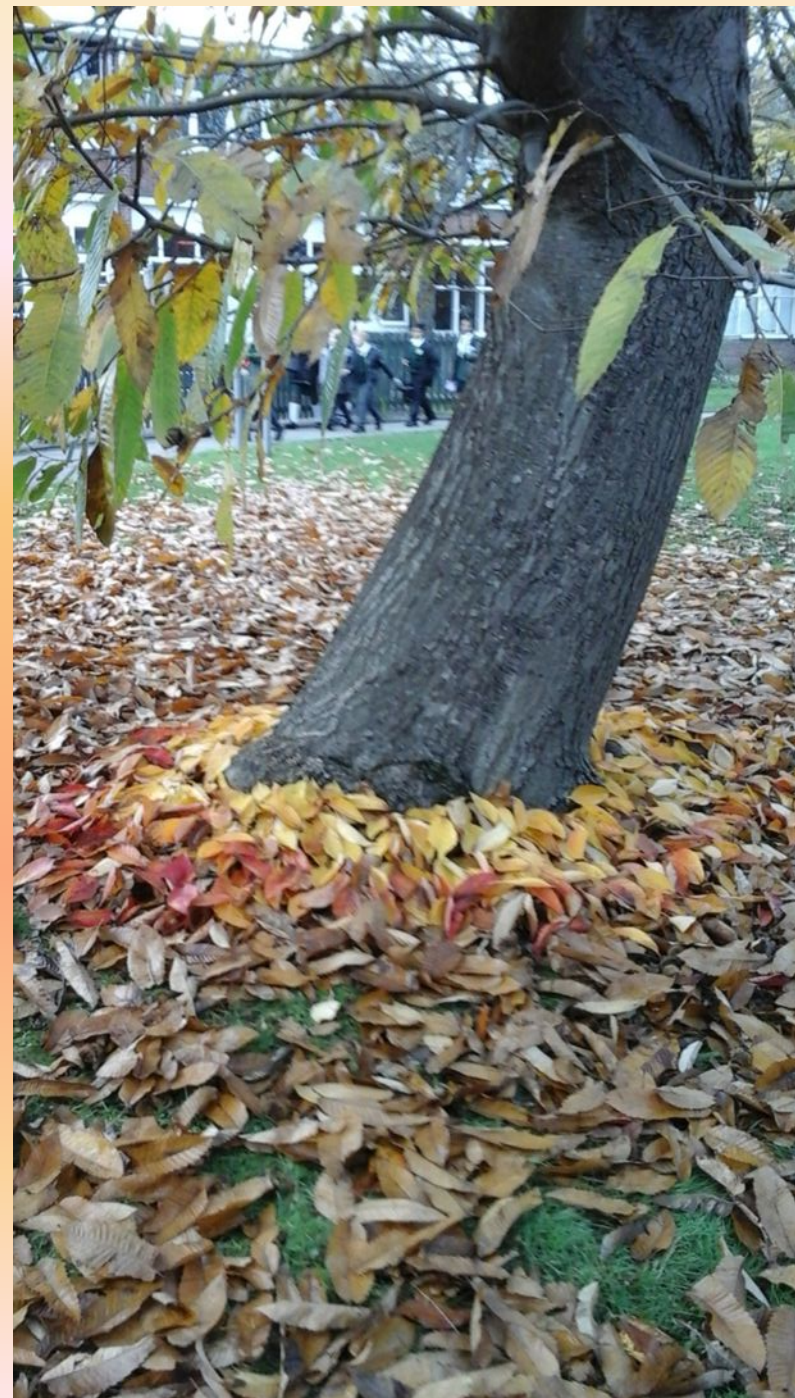




Next we hunted for brown leaves. We even found a mushroom camouflaged in all the brown leaves!
