Spelling patterns: turning adjectives ending -y into nouns and adverbs

Usually, when an adjective ending in –y needs to be changed into a noun or adverb, the y turns to an i, for example:



happy

happiness

happily

windy

windiness

windily

Can you change these adjectives to their noun and adverb form? Remember to turn the y into an i before you add the -ness / -ly ending!

hungry

heavy

greedy

pretty
