Thank you for all your support over the last two weeks. The pupils have been working well in lessons and teachers have reported how happy they have been with the approach they have had towards their learning.

As we approach the winter, we will see general illnesses increase. Obviously, please be cautious about sending unwell pupils to the Academy, but equally please do not feel that every illness requires 10 days of self-isolation. At the time of writing, we have had no positive tests for Covid-19 for any pupil or member of staff. We have had a small number of pupils who have had to isolate awaiting the results of a Covid-19 test, as they have shown one of the three main symptoms; they have all subsequently tested negative for Covid-19.


As clarification, if anyone in your household has <u>any</u> of the main symptoms of COVID-19 they should get a test as soon as possible and all members of the household should stay at home until you get the result. The main symptoms are:

- A HIGH TEMPERATURE This means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- A NEW, CONTINUOUS COUGH This means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- A LOSS OR CHANGE TO YOUR SENSE OF SMELL OR TASTE This means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

If you undertake a COVID-19 test please inform the Academy immediately of the results of the test.
