Explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object - link to topic: when the Tudors fired canons why did they eventually hit the ground?

Identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction, which act between moving surfaces - link to topic: Why did the Spanish Armada's fleet of ships float on water?

Recognise that some mechanisms, including levers, pulleys and gears, allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.
