Supplementary Information Forms for Church School Applications

If you are applying for a Secondary school place for your child and the school you are applying for requires a Supplementary Information Form, these must **only** be submitted to Father Cyriacus for signing if:-

You live in the parish of Our Lady of the Crays and this is where you and your family attend Mass (this does not include your child's attendance at Mass with the school)

Father Cyriacus is <u>not</u> in a position to sign your Supplementary Information Form just because your child attends St Peter and St Paul Catholic Primary Academy. His signature verifies your commitment to the Catholic faith demonstrated by your attendance at Mass at Our Lady of the Crays on Saturday or Sunday.

Please note, the same applies for Early Years applicants for the academic year 2021-2022

To all parents and carers of SEN children
