
Area Plan: Woodland Obstacle Course

Place hoops, beanbags, hurdles, skipping ropes (stretched out) and benches around the room. Children are animals travelling through the woods. They skip, hop, bounce and gallop. When they come to an obstacle they must do the appropriate actions to get over it.



Skipping rope (river): Bunny hop over it from side to side to the end.

Bench (log): Bounce along it. **Hoop (puddle):** Jump in to it and make a thin, wide or curled shape in the air.

Beanbags (boulders):

Hopscotch through them. Hurdles (hillock): Leap over them. **Mat (grassy bank):** Roll over it.
