### Holiday Activities and Food Programme

Bromley is running a holiday, activities and food programme. The programme will be operated for six weeks throughout 2021

The holiday activities and food programme provides activities and healthy meals during the school holidays for families with children and young people. The programme for Easter is for children over 8 years old who are also in receipt of benefits related free school meals. The activities will take place from 12<sup>th</sup> April. Parents and carers are advised that they will take a flexible approach to all face to face activities to ensure they adhere to the relevant government public health advice such as social distancing, however this will develop and change as they approach the summer and winter weeks of the programme.

Please note that limited spaces are available this Easter holiday. The activities programme is taking place at four locations across the borough. Booking is essential and once they have received your application, they will confirm whether they are able to offer a space.

### An Easter Message

Easter is the greatest feast in the Christian calendar. On this Sunday, Christians celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.

For Catholics, Easter Sunday comes at the end of 40 days of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving known as Lent. Through spiritual struggle and self-denial, we have prepared ourselves to die spiritually with Christ on Good Friday, the day of His Crucifixion, so that we can rise again with Him in new life on Easter.

Easter is a day of celebration because it represents the fulfillment of our faith as Christians. St. Paul wrote that, unless Christ rose from the dead, our faith is in vain (1 Corinthians 15:17).
