## Covid-19 Symptoms – Getting Tested

If you, or a member of your family, are displaying any symptoms of Covid-19 please get tested and isolate until you get a result. This should be a PCR test that is booked in, not a rapid lateral flow test. The rapid lateral flow test is for people without symptoms of Covid-19 who may be asymptomatic.

Get a PCR test as soon as possible if you have any of these symptoms:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste



You and anyone you live with should stay at home until you get your test result. Only leave your home to have a test. Anyone in your childcare or support bubble should also stay at home if you have been in close contact with them since your symptoms started or during the 48 hours before they started.

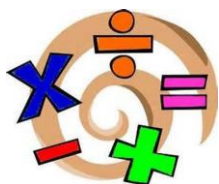

## Parents Wellbeing Workshops - for families who have children with additional needs

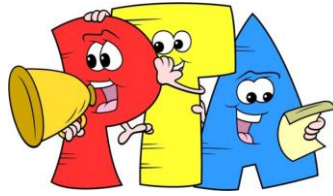
Bromley Mencap are running Wellbeing Workshops for families who have children with additional needs, focussing on the parent and their needs.
