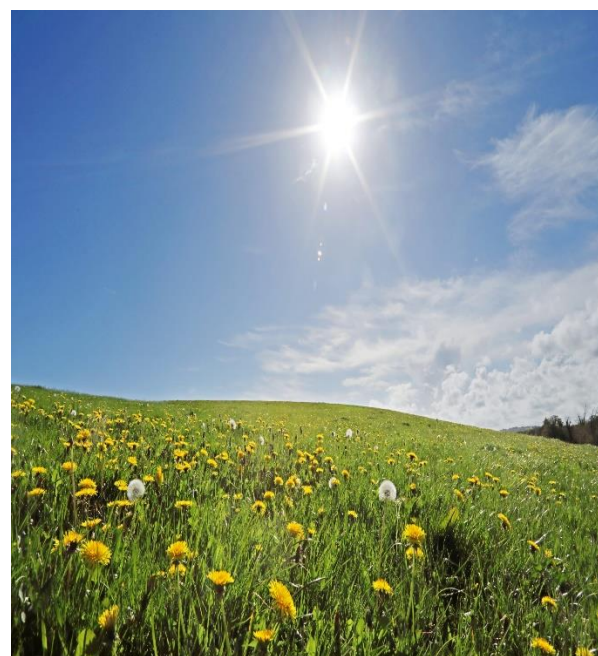

10 Top Tips to help you get your child to school on time.
