As ever, guidance from the DfE is slow in coming, but once I have further information I will write to you with more details.

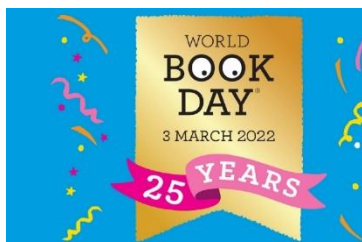
