Please can we remind parents/carers that we are a nut free school. This includes packed lunches on school trips.



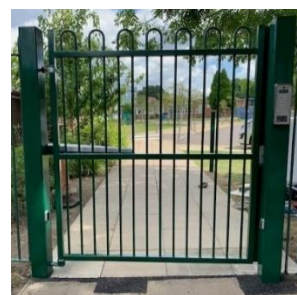
## Year 5 Metro Bank
