Swimming Championship

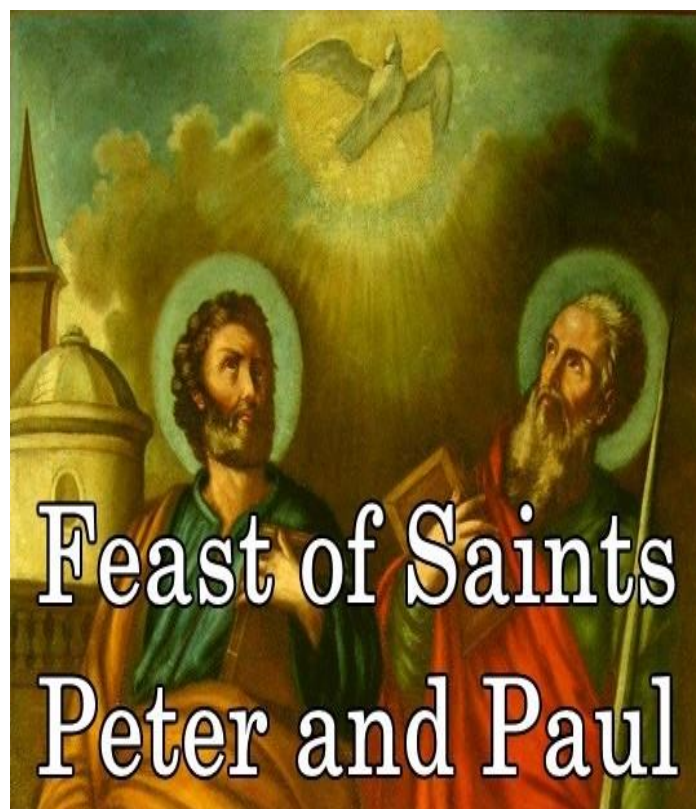
