FREE places and FREE nutritious lunches are available each week from Monday to Friday for children and young people entitled to Free School Meals

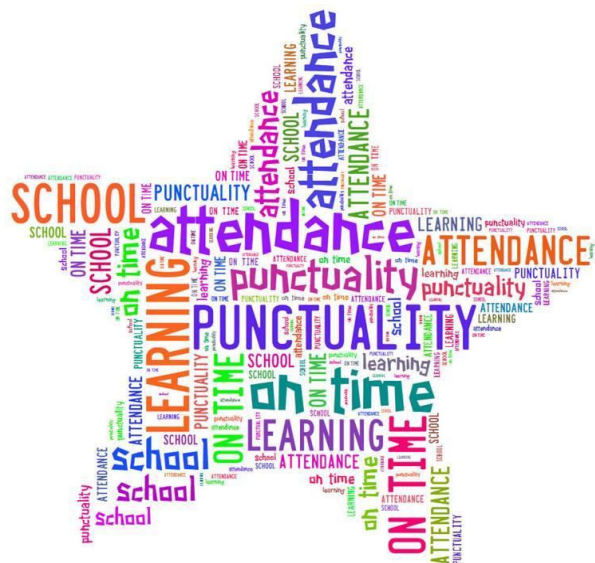

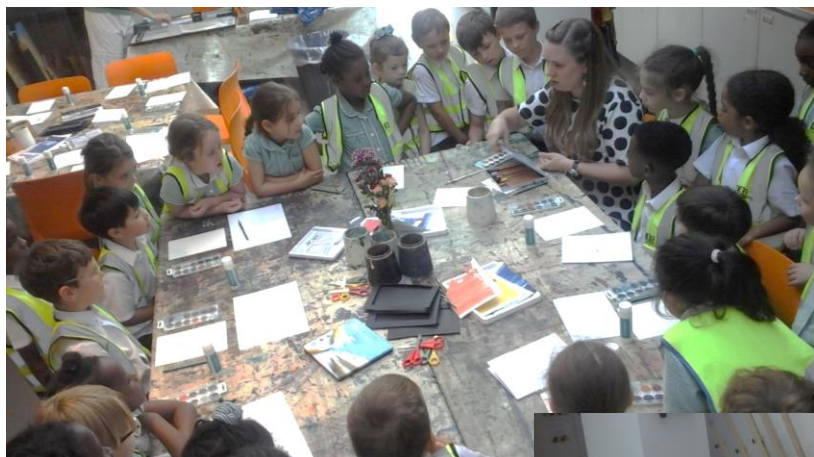
Sports Day
