#### **Reading Books**

You will notice that your child is now bringing two books home on a Monday and a Friday. The first is their usual reading scheme book that is matched to their phonic reading ability. These are changed on a Monday and a Friday. Children should be able to read these books fluently and independently.

Children will also have a 'reading for pleasure' book that they have selected. This book will be more challenging and is designed to be shared at home to encourage and foster a love of reading. The reading for pleasure book may take several weeks to complete if it is a longer chapter book.

Research shows that just 20 minutes of reading a day can expose children to over 2 million words and have a significant impact on educational outcomes. As an academy we are committed to promoting reading for pleasure across the school.

We encourage children to read a wide range of different books from all genres to expose children to the myriad of vocabulary and language that books have to offer.



#### Applications for Secondary School - Year 6 Pupils

You must apply for a secondary school place for your child to start Year 7 at secondary school when your child is in Year 6.

- Applications for Year 7 places in September 2023 open on 1 September 2022
- The national closing date for applications is **31 October 2022**
- The national offer date for on-time secondary applications is 1 March 2023

If you are a Bromley resident, you need to make your application through London Borough of Bromley. You can name schools outside of Bromley on your application if you wish.

If you live outside of Bromley, you need to apply through the local authority where you live and can name Bromley schools on that application if you wish.

You are strongly encouraged to apply online.

Please ensure that all required supporting documents are provided with your application to ensure that it can be processed without delay. Please see <u>application terms and conditions</u> for further information.
