Year 1 have been busy creating a Diversity Quilt to celebrate the diversity in their class. Great work Year 1!

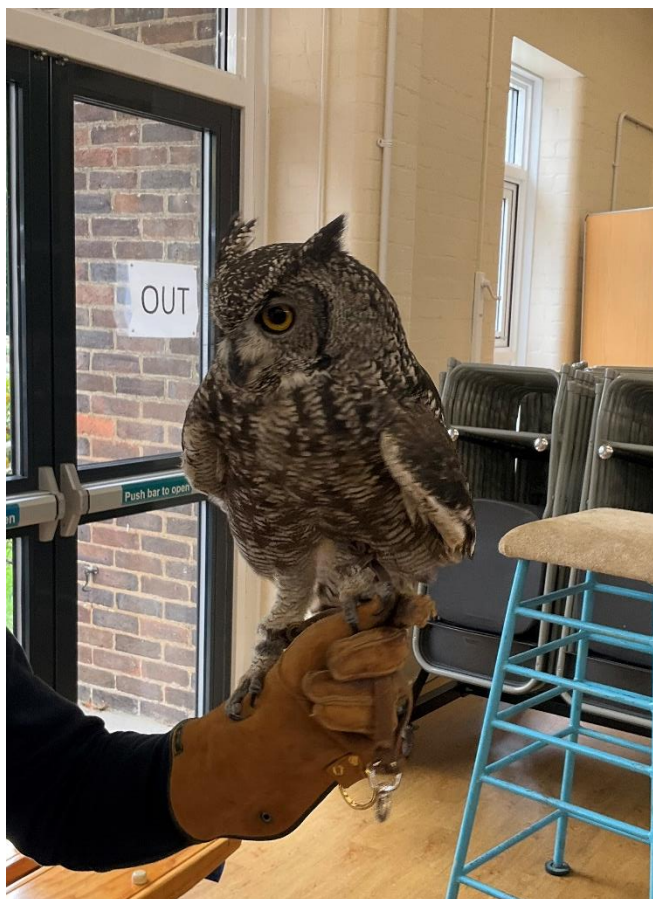


Owl Experience – 13th October 2022
