# Household Support Fund Summer 2023

The Academy, under the London Borough of Bromley, will provide a payment of £90 per pupil at the end of July for those who receive Free School Meals (FSM). In September we intend to hold Calpol/Paracetamol on the Academy premises and should your child need a single dose of medicine, along with your permission, we can administer it. With this in mind, if your child needs more than one dose, it may be questioned that your child is not well enough to be in school. 


# Author Visit











