Pablo Picasso

Pablo Picasso was born on 25th October 1881 in Malaga, Spain. Picasso's father, Jose Ruiz Blaso, was also a painter who was very good at painting birds. Picasso went to a special art school. In 1904, Picasso permanently settled in Paris. Picasso married his second wife, Jacqueline Roque, in 1961. They were married until Picasso's death in 1973. Picasso had four children.
