Firework Safety


Despite annual safety warnings, firework celebrations still end in painful injuries for too many people, including very young children. Yet fireworks can be great fun for families, not just around November 5 (Bonfire Night/Guy Fawkes Night), but also Diwali, New Year's Eve and Chinese New Year.

Only adults should deal with setting up firework displays, the lighting of fireworks and the safe disposal of fireworks once they have been used (and remember, alcohol and fireworks don't mix!). Children and young people should be supervised and watch and enjoy fireworks at a safe distance.

Keith Haring

Keith Haring was born 4th May 1958 in Reading, Pennsylvania, USA. He died 16th February 1990 (aged 31), New York City, USA. He had three younger sisters and his parents were Joan and Allen Haring. He went to both Pittsburgh Centre for the Arts and School of Visual Arts in New York City. During his lifetime, Keith Haring did a lot of work for the benefit of children, especially those in disadvantaged areas.
