

Tech Club will be in touch with the school in the future to potentially run an Easter holiday camp. If this is the case, please register your interest early to avoid disappointment.




### A Message from Your Chair of Governors



# Cubist inspired

#### FEBRUARY'S ART CHALLENGE

Cubism is a style of art that was invented in 1907. Cubist artists try to break an object or person up into different parts. This often makes the painting look like they are made up of geometric shapes like cubes. Pablo Picasso was one of the first artists to explore Cubism. He was born in Spain but later moved to Paris, France. He wanted to paint things that he felt, remembered and saw all in one painting.



Pablo Picasso worked closely with a French artist called Georges Braque. In 1908, Braque painted one of the first Cubist landscapes.

It was called 'Houses of L'Estaque'.

An art critic who saw the painting said that it looked like it was made of cubes. This style of painting then became known as cubism.

Decide on some warm colours to use to complete each section of the heart and cold colours for the background.

Your challenge is to create a piece of artwork that is inspired by Cubism.

- black marker or pen
- ruler
- pencil
- · watercolour or acrylic paints
- · cup of water
- paintbrush
- black paper or card for mounting your artwork


