


#### World Book Day


through using images of Easter bunnies, chocolate, carrots or flowers. In terms of creativity, the sky is the limit!

#### Calpol and Nurofen

We have noticed that we have recently been asked to administer Nurofen by parents. As you are aware, historically we have never offered either of the two. We are now happy to administer Calpol as a one off administration however unfortunately if your child requires us to administer Calpol twice in the day or follow up with a close administration of Nurofen we will deem your child as not well enough to be in school. We will still not keep Nurofen on site so should you wish your child to have some, this will need to be provided. We would like you all to acknowledge and understand that this medicine should not be used to mask the temperature of your child and should they have a temperature in the morning, please do not send them to school. We love having your children in school but a very poorly child is not going to learn and it is not in their best interest to be here.


