

Sickness Policy

We would like to remind all parents of the Academy policy for sickness and diarrhea. Please ensure all children do not attend the Academy for a 48 hour period from the last occurrence of either sickness or diarrhea. This is important so your child returns to good health and the risk of infection is reduced. These guidelines are issued by National Health England.

If your child is absent from the Academy due to ill health or a family emergency please contact the Academy Office before 10am. It is the policy of the Academy that all pupils are accounted for every day in order to ensure they are safe. Please note that failure to do this is a safeguarding risk and may result in Social Care being contacted.

Winter PE Kit

Please ensure your child has a winter PE kit in school, including a tracksuit for outdoor PE, from next week. Academy PE tracksuits can be purchased from the Academy Office for \pounds 16.50 each.

Spare Underwear and Wellingtons


