

Clocks Spring Forward this Weekend

Did you know? William Willett was the man who introduced the idea of British Summer Time, also known as Daylight Saving Time, in 1907. He was keen to prevent people wasting vital hours of light during summer mornings. He published a pamphlet called 'The Waste of Daylight' in a bid to get people out of bed earlier by changing the nation's clocks. Mr Willetts home was in Petts Wood and he is commemorated for his efforts by a memorial sundial in woods behind the Academy, set permanently to Daylight Saving Time. The Daylight Inn in Petts Wood is named in his honour and there is a road there called Willett Way. So don't forget to spring our clocks forward by an hour this weekend.
