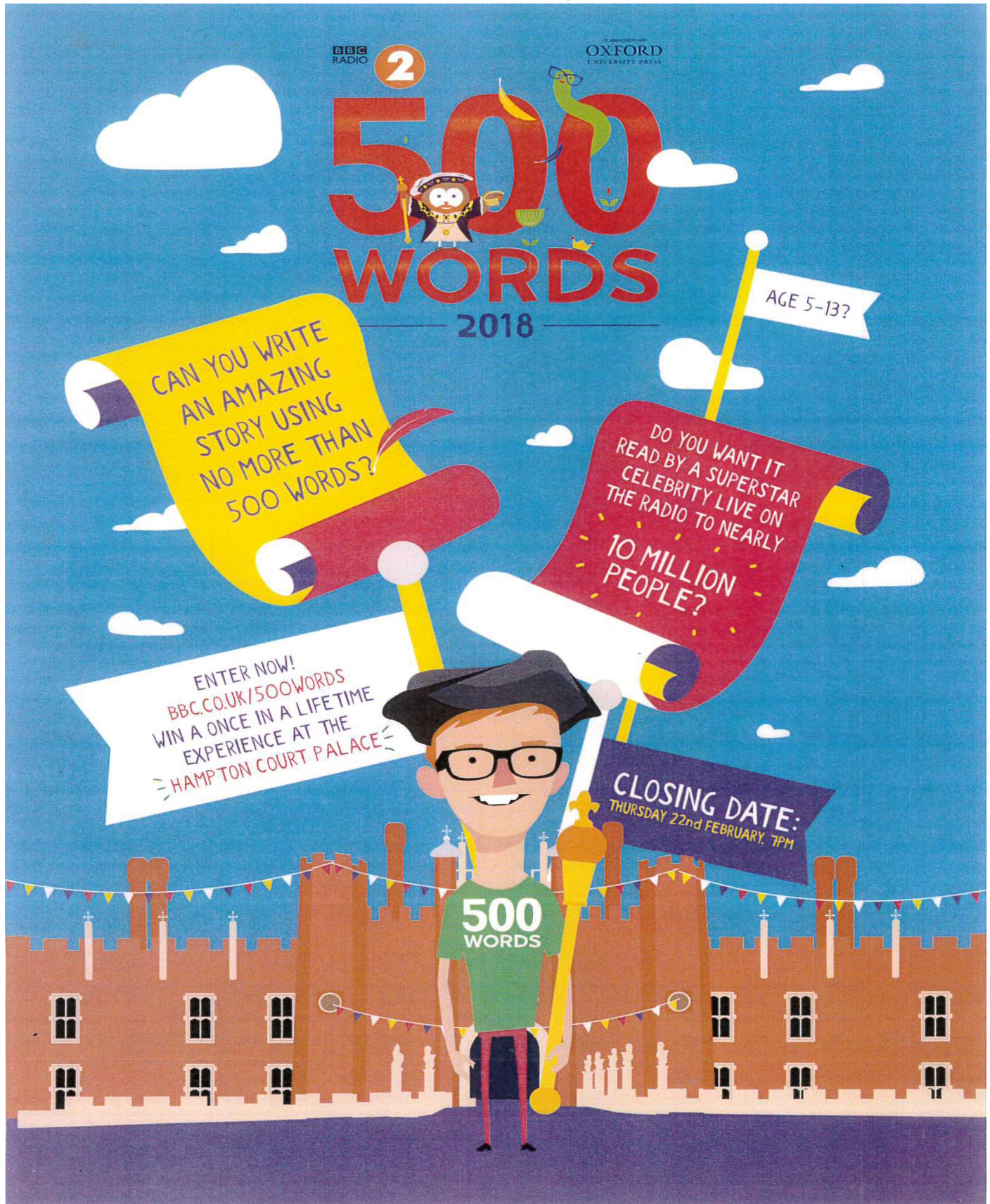
The Academy has been given three large hens
