Science Challenge

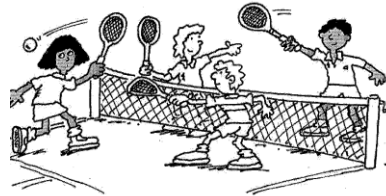
Our normal numbering system is a decimal system (0-9).
