1. Some facts about Michael Morpurgo, the famous English children's author.
 - Michael Morpurgo was born on 5th October 1943 in St Albans, Hertfordshire.
 - He has written over 100 books. Private Peaceful was his 100th title.
 - After graduating from university, Michael became a primary school teacher in Kent. He writes all of his books in exercise books. He doesn't work on a desk, instead he sits on his bed, propped up with pillows. His favourite animals are elephants. Some of his favourite authors include: Robert Louis Stevenson, Rudyard Kipling and Ted Hughes. Michael set up the Farms for City Children project with his wife, Clare. It gives deprived urban children a chance to work on a farm and enjoy the benefits of being outdoors in the countryside.
 - Michael was given an OBE in 2006.
 - In 2003 he became the Children's Laureate, becoming the third person to fulfill the role.
 - He has three children: Sebastian, Horatio and Rosalind, and several grandchildren.
 - He likes listening to Mozart, but he can only write in a silent room.
 - Michael loved French at school and he went on to study this subject at university.
