Dear Parents/Carers,

- \*Use resources to make the face of a family member on a paper plate. Your child could add wool for the hair etc.

- \*A painting to show a family hobby, e.g. going swimming together.

- \*A drawing of a particular family event, e.g. family wedding/baptism etc.

- \*Food wrappers to indicate what their family likes to eat.

- \*A list of the family rules.

- \*Other relevant photos related to the topic.

The children will have their work displayed in the classroom. We hope this will be a special display to remind the children of their loving family at home.
