Health for Life Fortnight

Next week sees the start of our annual Health for Life Fortnight. The first week will concentrate upon healthy bodies, where the children will learn all about the many ways we can keep our body healthy. The second week will concentrate upon healthy minds, where the children will learn mindfulness techniques and how to care for their own wellbeing. There will be many activities carried out over these two weeks including fitness routines, additional physical activity sessions, yoga and mindfulness activities. Charity Run

Over the last 2 years, Mr Lindsay has organised a Terry Fox Memorial Run to raise money for cancer research and awareness. Throughout those two years, More than £2500 has been raised to support a tremendous cause. As you may have heard, at the beginning of the Summer Mr Lindsay's mother, Kim Renders, sadly passed away. This year, instead of the Terry fox run, Mr Lindsay has decided to organise a run in memory of her. It will be known as the 'Renders Run'

During her entire life Kim was heavily involved in theatre as an actor, director, designer, professor and playwright. She was one of the founding members of Canada's oldest feminist theatre company, *Nightwood Theatre*, which has played a pivotal role in promoting woman in the arts. It was Kim's wishes that instead of flowers, a donation should be made to *Nightwood Theatre*. A current fundraising campaign in Canada for this cause has reached \$3500, with the goal being \$5000. We hope that we can help to achieve this goal. The run will be the conclusion to the Academy's 'Health for Life Fortnight', with all children taking part and giving their best effort. Donations will be collected during the weeks leading up to the run which is taking place on the afternoon of 5th October 2018. Thank you in advance for your support and participation
