The Tate Year 3 Project was launched this week, at Tate Britain, revealing the Turner Prize winning artist behind the project to be **Steve McQueen**, Oscar-winning director of 12 Years a Slave.

At the same time that Steve McQueen was explaining his vision, the first 5 Ambassador schools had their photography session with the Tate photographers with a variety of activities alongside the photo and some great questions being asked by the children.

The Tate photographers will be visiting our Academy on Wednesday 16th October to take the pictures of Year 3.

Uniform


Please note earrings are not part of the Academy Uniform. Studs/hoops are not allowed to be worn. Please remove your child's earrings over the weekend. Thank you.
