Multiplying by 20

Remember: To multiply by 20, first multiply by 2, and then 10

Example: 23 x 20 =

• 23 x 2 = 46

 46 x 10 = 460 \rightarrow So, 23 x 20 = 460 \odot

Multiplying by 9

Remember: Multiply first by 10, then subtract the input (starting number)

Example: 23 x 9

• 23 x 10 = 230
$$\rightarrow$$
 230 – 23 = 207 \rightarrow So, 23 x 10 = 207 \odot
