Multiplying by 20

Remember: To multiply by 20, first multiply by 2, and then 10

Example:  $23 \times 20 =$

- $23 \times 2 = 46 \rightarrow 46 \times 10 = 460 \rightarrow$  So,  $23 \times 20 = 460$  😊

Multiplying by 9

Remember: Multiply first by 10, then subtract the input (starting number)

Example:  $23 \times 9$

- $23 \times 10 = 230 \rightarrow 230 - 23 = 207 \rightarrow$  So,  $23 \times 10 = 207$  😊
