

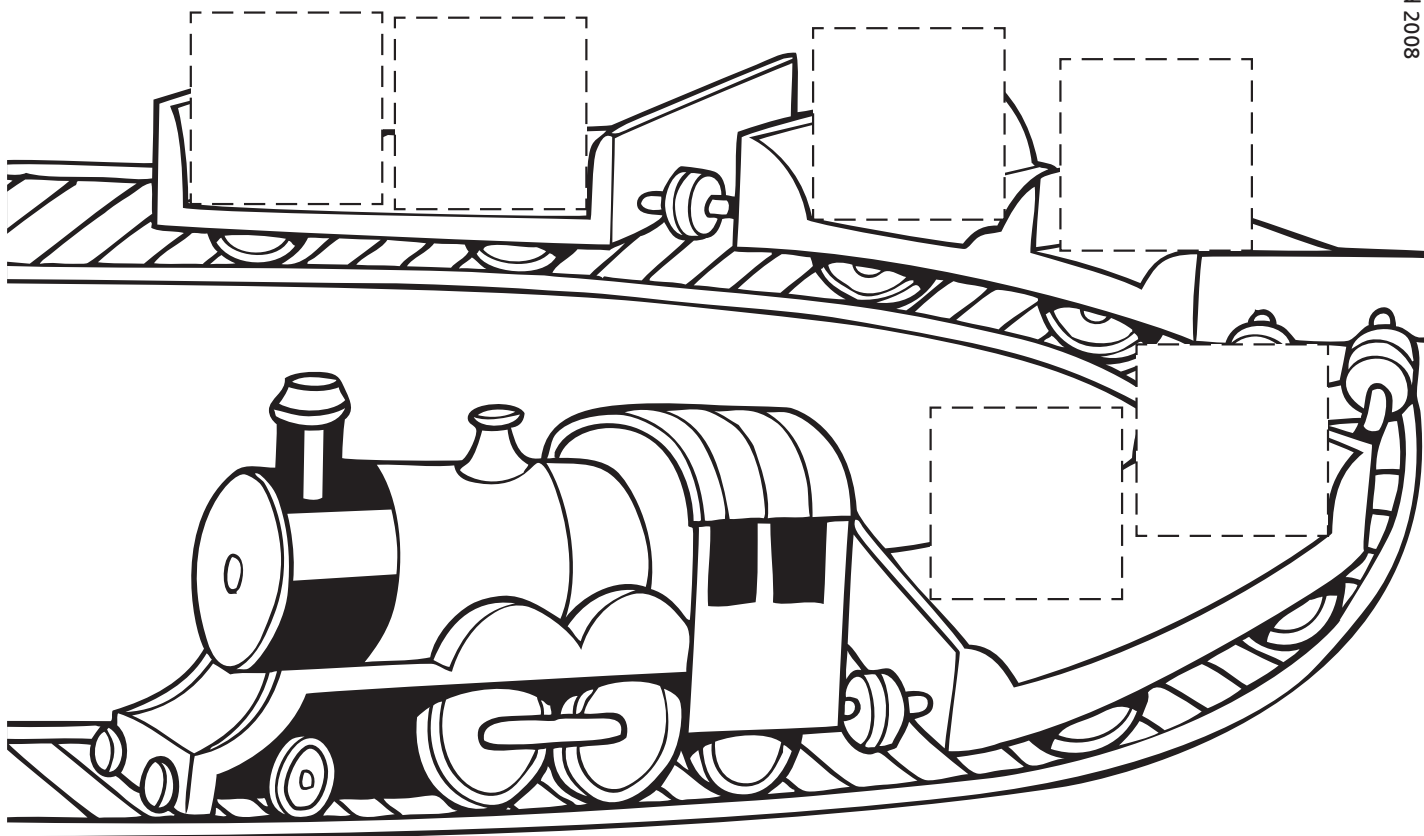
Putting animals on a train

This week we have been reading *Oi! Get Off Our Train*. In the story various animals asked to travel on our train, because they were endangered and needed our help.

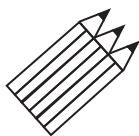
Help your child to cut out some of the animals below, and put them into the trucks on the train. If they prefer, they could draw their own animals.

Talk about which animals your child would take on their train and why. They need not all be endangered:

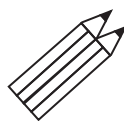
- *Where do these animals live?*
