

Counting carriages

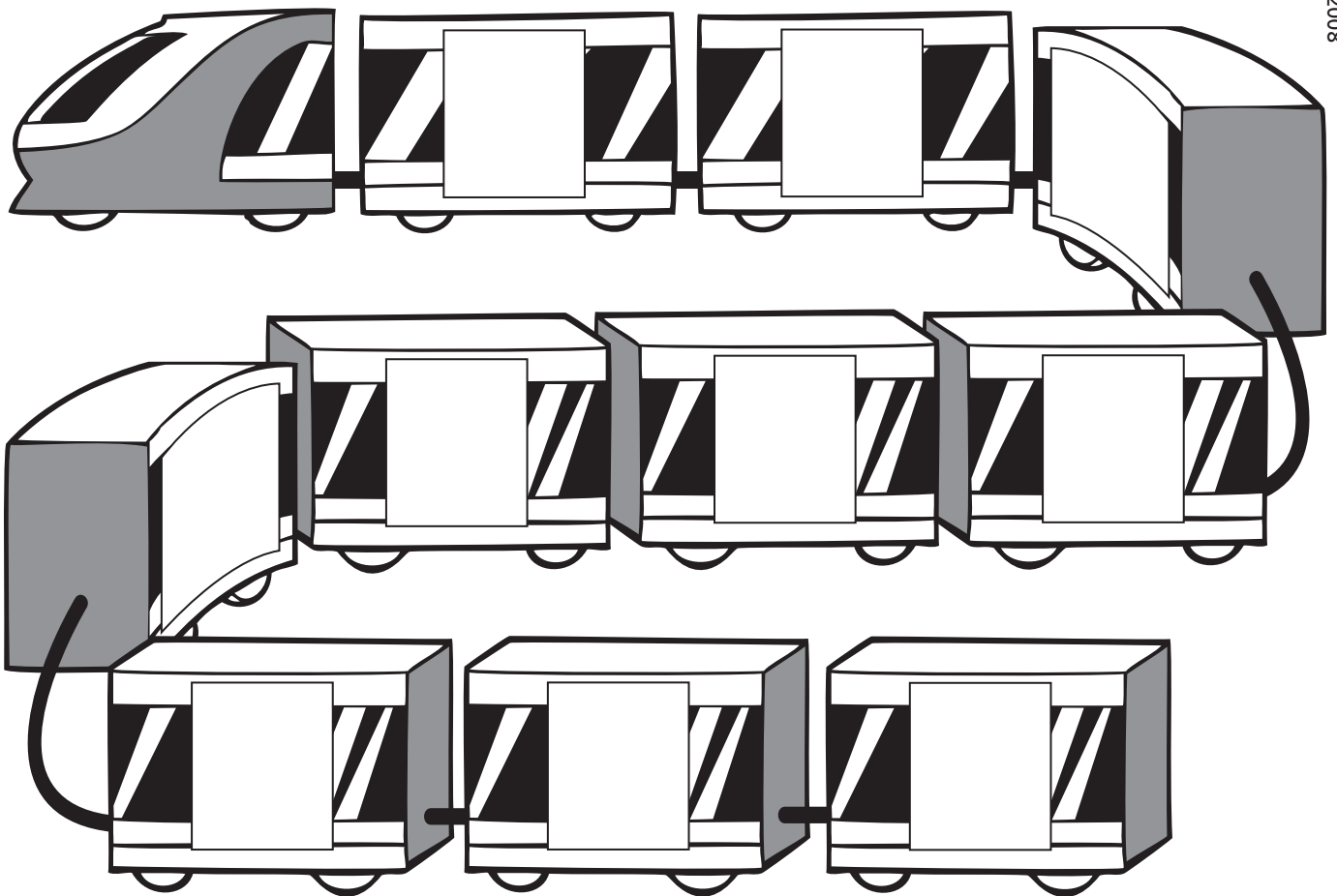
This week we have been recognising and writing numbers, and reading *Oi! Get Off Our Train*.

Count the train carriages (not the engine!) below together. Help your child to point at each carriage in turn as you say the number. When s/he is confident, help your child to write the correct number on each carriage.

If you have time, your child may like to colour in or decorate the carriages.

Ask questions about the carriages, for example:

- Which carriage is coloured blue?
- How many carriages come after carriage 5?
- What number is the carriage that comes after carriage 8?
