Using the different parts of verbs is part of understanding the grammatical functions of different words in a sentence. This activity also asks children be as imaginative as possible.

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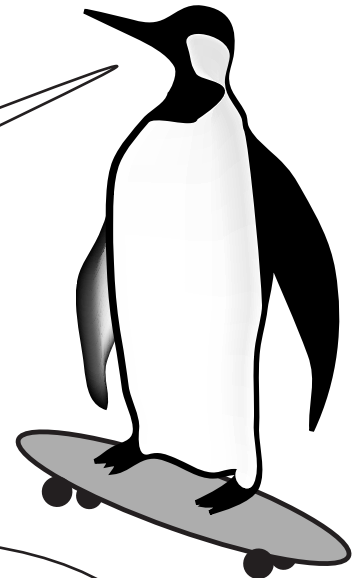
*A dancing tiger.*
