## Money word problems

### One step problems

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- 1. Laura spent £1.75 on a birthday card and £1.99 on wrapping paper for her friend's birthday. How much did she spend altogether?
- 2. An adult ticket for a football match costs £3.80 more than a child's ticket. If the child's ticket costs £14.60, how much does the adult ticket cost?
- 3. Sue saw a book she liked for £7.99. In the sale it was reduced by £2.49. What was the reduced price of the book?
- 4. Sam has £27.10 in his wallet. He buys a DVD for £14.90. How much money does he have left?

# Two step problems (You will need to do 2 calculations to work out these questions)

- 1. Every book in the bookshop is on a special offer price of £2.99. Emma buys 3 books. How much does she spend? How much change will she get from £10.00?
- 2. Harry went to the cinema. He bought a ticket which cost £5.49, a bag of popcorn which cost £3.99 and a drink for £1.99. How much did Harry spend? He paid with a £20 note. How much change did he get?
- 3. For her birthday, Rebecca was given £30. She went shopping and bought a cycle helmet for £14.34 and a pair of gloves for £2.85. How much birthday money did she have left after her shopping trip?
