Over the next three weeks, you are going to be an explorer / naturalist like Charles Darwin. You are going to seek out a location to test its biodiversity. You are going to focus on a particular species of plant or animal; draw (scientifically) and write a report on it.

Top Tips:

Biodiversity – the amount of species in a given location (ecosystem). The more the better. Remove one species, the whole system could collapse!

You could choose your garden or local park to explore and gather your information.

Be outside as much as possible. Build a hide, bug box, etc to attract wildlife.

Your report can be presented anyway you like. The points below are things you could add.

- List all the species biodiversity in your garden
- Out of all of the species you encountered, choose your favourite (Dragonfly for example).
- A detailed report and drawing for your species
