They are roving reporters that can move around sentences telling us how (manner), where (place) or when (time) something happened.

Add adverbials to these sentences and remember to add a comma (,) after it when it is at the front of the sentence (fronted adverbial).

Example: Verb

<u>In the morning</u>, Colin wriggled <u>quietly</u> towards <u>the leaf of the flower</u> so he could have breakfast.
