Answer these problems using column method addition

1. $3528 + 2471 =$
2. $4552 + 3726 =$
3. $6746 + 2465 =$
4. $4538 + 6537 =$
5. $8427 + 7312 =$
6. $3857 + 8574 =$

For the next questions, remember what a palindrome is: a number that is the same forwards and backwards. For example: 12321, 53435, 78687

7. Write three additions using 5-digit palindromes that equals a palindrome

Example: $13431 + 52325 = 65756$

8. Write three 7-digit palindromes. You may not use the same digit repeating over and over.

Example: 1432341

Not accepted: 2222222

9. Write 3 additions using 5-digit palindromes that will add to 99999

Example: $13431 + 86568 = 99999$
