

Year 5 Maths Homework - 7th October

Multiplying by 20

Remember: To multiply by 20, first multiply by 2, and then 10

Example: $23 \times 20 =$

- $23 \times 2 = 46 \rightarrow 46 \times 10 = 460 \rightarrow$ So, $23 \times 20 = 460$ 😊
- 1. $31 \times 20 =$
- 2. $15 \times 20 =$
- 3. $26 \times 20 =$
- 4. $33 \times 20 =$
- 5. $44 \times 20 =$
- 6. $35 \times 20 =$
- 7. $28 \times 20 =$
- 8. $39 \times 20 =$

Multiplying by 9

Remember: Multiply first by 10, then subtract the input (starting number)

Example: 23×9

- $23 \times 10 = 230 \rightarrow 230 - 23 = 207 \rightarrow$ So, $23 \times 9 = 207$ 😊
- 9. $16 \times 9 =$
- 10. $36 \times 9 =$
- 11. $45 \times 9 =$
- 12. $28 \times 9 =$
- 13. $39 \times 9 =$
