Stars Increase 2020

At St Peter and St Paul Catholic Primary Academy we believe in open communication with all our parents/carers, so with this in mind we would like to inform you of an increase in the cost of our extended day provision ‘Stars’. We set our prices to achieve an affordable charging structure that allows the Academy to offer excellent provision at as low a cost as possible. As we have not raised our prices since ‘Stars’ began in January 2013, and the rise in costs to run the extended day provision, we will be increasing our breakfast and evening prices from the start of the summer term – Monday 20th April 2020. We hope by giving you plenty of notice that you will be able to prepare for this change.
