Young Voices Rehearsal and Concert at The O2 – Thursday 6th February 2020

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR THOSE CHILDREN TAKING PART IN THE ABOVE



On the day of the concert, your child should arrive as normal where they will be registered and take part in morning lessons. They need to arrive wearing their Young Voices t-shirt (or a plain white short sleeved t-shirt if you did not purchase the official t-shirt) with their normal Academy uniform. School bags need to be left at home. Your child will have lunch before leaving for the concert at the Academy, so please provide a normal packed lunch for your child if they do not have a cooked lunch. **Please also provide your child with a packed evening meal**, to eat at the O2 Arena. Your child may also bring a snack for normal morning break time and one for the concert and enough drink for the day and evening. All food and drink for that day should be in a disposable bag.

After morning lessons and an early lunch, the children will travel to the O2 Arena by coach (provided by the Academy). The children will then take part in the rehearsal before the evening concert. The concert starts at 7pm (doors open at 5.30pm) and ends at 9pm. **Please note that all children will travel home by coach and you will need to collect your child from the Academy between approximately 10-10.30pm.**

If you need to make any emergency contact on the day of the concert please call the Academy Office. The office staff will be able to assist you up until 4pm that day. If you need to make contact after 4pm please call **07733 631065**. This mobile telephone number will be kept on during the hours of 4pm and 6pm. Between the hours of 6pm and 9.15pm the phone will be switched off as the concert will be taking place.
