Actions Taken To Mitigate the Risk of COVID-19

St Peter and St Paul Catholic Primary Academy is committed to safeguarding their pupils, staff and wider community. We would like to reiterate that whilst there have been **no reported cases of coronavirus, of anyone coming into contact with the virus** the Academy have made the difficult decision to take precautionary measures to ensure that we stay open for our pupils: safeguarding is our number one priority.

The following steps will be taken and we ask for your support at this challenging time:

- Parents are asked to phone the Academy regarding any issues/queries they may have, rather than coming into reception in the first instance.
- Visitors to site will be by the Principal's authorisation only - where possible, video calling will be used to replace face to face meetings.
- Trips out of the Academy will be postponed until further notice - we will endeavour to ensure that pupils will be given the same opportunity wherever possible once the risk has been eliminated.
- Pupils are being encouraged to wash their hands thoroughly and regularly and have been shown how to do this.
- Pupils with severe medical needs: we are in the process of contacting parents of pupils with medical conditions asking them to seek medical advice.
