Remember that editing is reading over your work and then correcting for spelling as well as improving what you have written - sometimes that will mean adding a word or two or taking some away - try to make your writing flow as you read it and think about what you are trying to make your reader think and feel.

Things to look for:

- Capital letters and full stops
- Commas, especially after fronted adverbials
- Adding for flow - adjectives, adverbials, conjunctions, prepositions or similes
- Finally, check your spelling (perhaps ask your adult to help you with this part)
