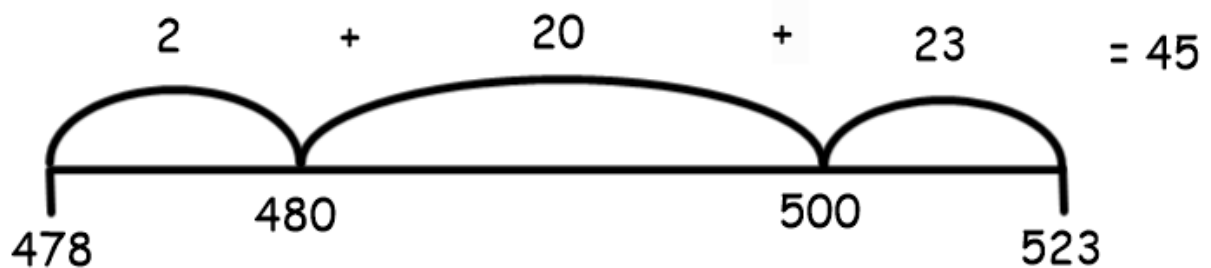
Today, we will be subtracting 3-digit numbers using counting up.

Remember our frog is lazy and likes going to the next multiple of 10 for a rest.

One more thing to remember, the smaller number goes at the left-hand end of your number line and the larger number (the number the frog is jumping towards) goes at the right-hand end of your number line.

Here's an example:

$$523 - 478 = 45$$
