

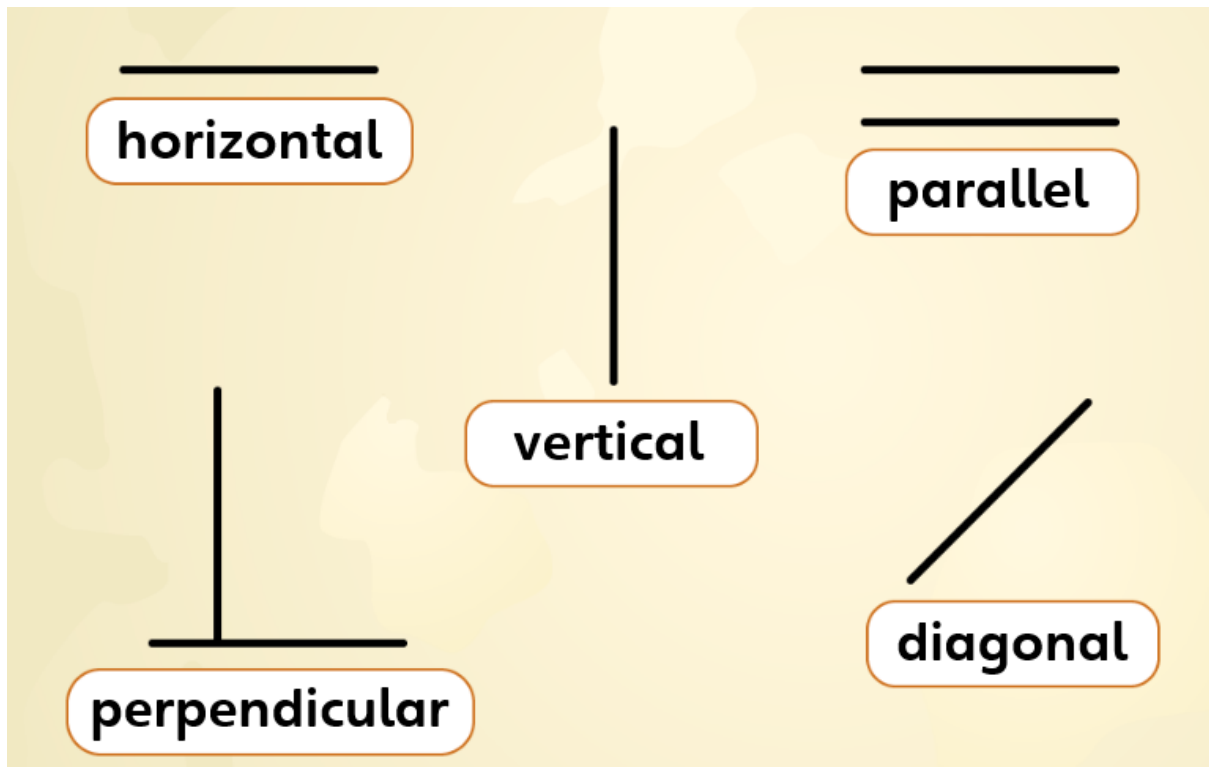
Maths

Lines - Parallel lines - never meet, touch or cross.

Perpendicular lines - two lines which meet at a right angle (90 degrees).

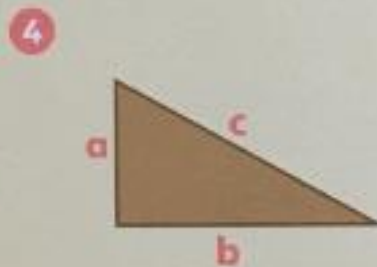
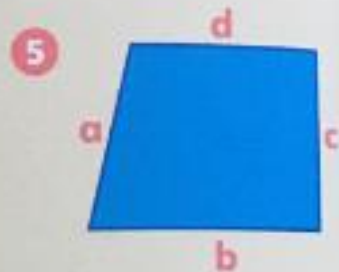
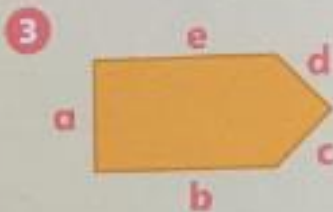
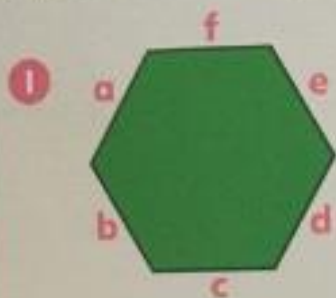


Polygons are 2-dimensional shapes. They are made of straight lines, and the shape is "closed" (all the lines connect up).
